Chris graduated in Music and Drama from Aberystwyth, and trained to teach at Goldsmiths. In 2007 Chris set up the BA Hons Illustration at CSAD and led the programme until 2014. He co-founded Illustration Research in 2010.

From 1990-2002 years Chris worked as a designer for leading animation companies in the UK and Europe and as a visual arts/music educator with Children's Music Workshop, WMC, Glyndebourne Education, Fundacio la Caixa and other musical organisations. This led to teaching animation and drawing in Cardiff, Denmark and Reunion Island.

Since 2013 Chris has developed new forms of visual facilitation combining the convention of visual meetings with puppetry and info-graphics. Themes have ranged from NHS organisational development, Learning Information Systems and Healthy University consultations for Cardiff Met, and Clinical Innovation with Cardiff Met and PDR. All these activities have involved CSAD students and graduates.

Chris has illustrated a number of children's books including *The Gardening Pirates* and *Ble Mae Twts?* by his partner Ruth Morgan. In his spare time he is a piano accompanist and emergency organist.
