Safe access to on-campus labs, studios, workshops and teaching spaces with controlled and managed numbers

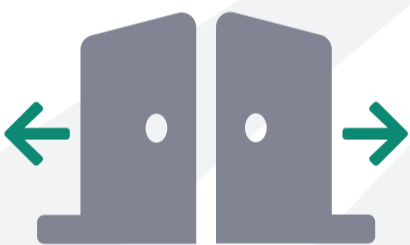
Additional access to the city-wide cycle hire system, Next Bikes, to reduce the requirement for public transport
