# I've got my Student Met Card What now?

## *Adding money to your card*

Add money to your Met card online at [Cardiffmet.ac.uk/payment](http://Cardiffmet.ac.uk/payment) using Worldpay or PayPal.

## *Printing and copying*

Use your student card to access and pay at the self-service printers, copiers and Print Studio services

## *Buying food and drink*

Use your card in any of the University's catering outlets\* instead of cash and as a loyalty card.

\*Excluding the Student Union

## *Campus access*

Your student card will get you through all main campus buildings and doors.  
Contact your programme director if you require additional access.

## *Residential Students in Cyncoed and Plas Gwyn*

Cyncoed students should visit the halls office (Warwick house) to have room access added to their new Met card.

Students in Plas Gwyn halls should visit the Plas Gwyn halls office.

Visit the halls office for all accommodation enquiries.

## *Catering*

If you're a catered student or you've purchased the "lunch club" meal deal, visit Warwick house to have your meal tokens added to your new student Met card. Simply present your card to the till operator.

**Catering Extra Bite Loyalty card scheme**  
Collect loyalty points on all purchases over £1.00. Save money by using your points to purchase food and drinks in University's catering outlets. Simply present your Met card each time you make a purchase

## *IT access and services*

Once enrolled your IT account, Library access and WiFi is automatically active. Accounts for Moodle, the Library and Blackboard are created within 24 hours. Visit the helpdesks in the Cyncoed and Llandaff IT suites with an IT queries.

## *Library*

Visit NIAC (Cyncoed) and The Gym in Llandaff to have your gym access activated.

## *Gym membership*

Visit NIAC (Cyncoed) and The Gym in Llandaff to have your gym access activated.

## *Student loans*

Visit, telephone or email one of the i-zones with your query.

## *Cycle shelters*

Visit, email or phone either Cyncoed Reception or Llandaff i-zone (029 2020 5600) and ask for cycle shelter access.

## *The Study First Bursary*

If you've received confirmation you've been accepted onto the Study First Bursary, the Met Card Info desk will be able to activate your bursary on your card.

You should also complete your Met Rider Bus Pass application or provide details of your rented accommodation to the Info desk.
