



Embedding Panopto videos in Moodle

In most instances, it's advisable to use the '**Add an Activity or Resource > Panopto**' process for adding Panopto content to Moodle, as this affords students the benefits of the full Panopto interface - such as **Search**, **Speed control** and **Indexing**. It's much more **student-centred** than an embedded video, as the Panopto web interface puts the student in full control of their own learning. It's also a very **quick and easy** method for staff adding Panopto content to Moodle. However, in some circumstances, you may wish to provide a more **visually integrated learning experience** - and here, embedding a video might work better:


1. Open your **Panopto dashboard** via this link: <https://cardiffmet.cloud.panopto.eu>
2. **Sign-in to Panopto** using the '**Moodle**' option (your browser may default to the 'Panopto' option)
3. **Locate** the video you wish to embed, and click the adjacent '**Share**' button
4. A **pop-up** will open, click the purple '<> **Embed**' button

5. The **Width** setting will default to **720**, but this can be a little too wide for some displays, so please change this to either **560** or **480**
6. Click the '**Copy Embed Code**' button
7. **Logon to Moodle**, and open the **relevant module**
8. Click '**Turn editing on**' from the main Cog menu
9. Find the **location** in the module where you'd like to embed the Panopto video

10. Click **'Add an Activity or Resource'**

11. Select the **'Label'** Resource



12. When the edit/upload page opens, click the **<> 'edit HTML source'** button

13. A **pop-up** will open, and in here **paste** your Panopto **embed code**

14. Click **'Update'**

15. You should see the **video has embedded**

16. Click **'Save and return to course'**

17. The video may not render properly on the page until you **'Turn editing off'**
