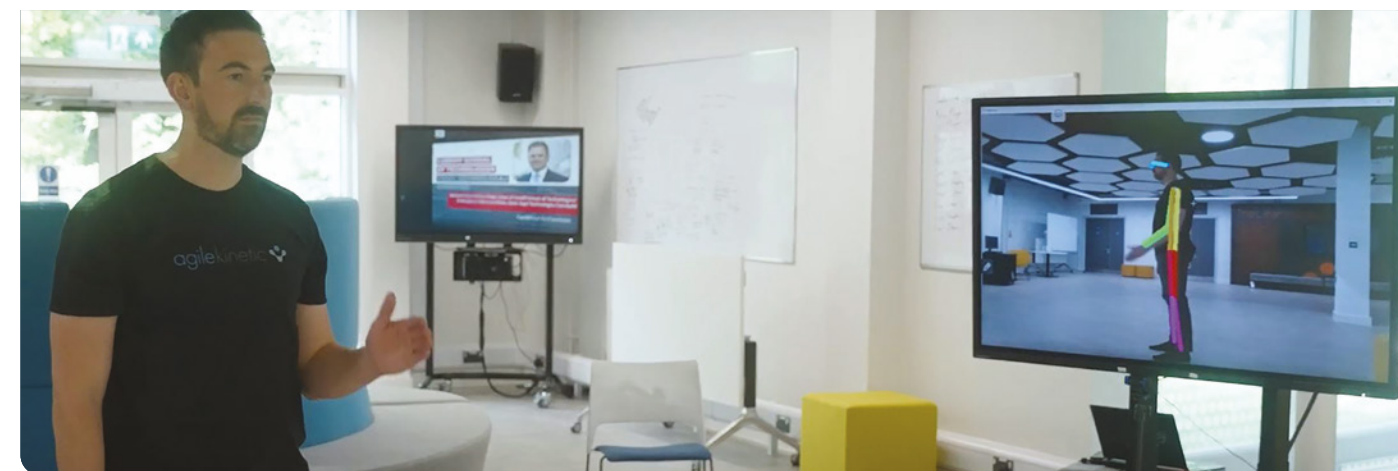


About the Agile Kinetic industry-university collaboration

The industry-university collaboration between Cardiff Metropolitan University and Agile Kinetic was backed by the Welsh Government funded SMART Partnership programme. This partnership enabled the founder of Agile Kinetic, Peter Bishop and his team, to move from what was a business idea to “having a product for sale”.

As a result of collaboratively working with Cardiff Metropolitan University, the team at Agile Kinetic has notably impacted on transforming the quality of post NHS procedure care, through the use artificial intelligence to allow anyone anywhere to gain insight from movement on devices they already own. This technology can be applied in many different settings. However, the business is focussing initially on the medical and healthcare sector because the backlog of surgeries is too high and there is a real demand for innovation.

Through this project, the team at Agile Kinetic delivered many impactful outcomes which align to the Welsh Government’s Well-Being of Future Generations Act 2015 including A More Resilient Wales, coping with an ageing population through using cutting edge technologies to enable a significant reduction in the need for physical appointments. Also, A Healthier Wales, supporting a society in which people’s physical well-being is maximised, as this technology will enable mass screening and early identification of conditions such as frailty.

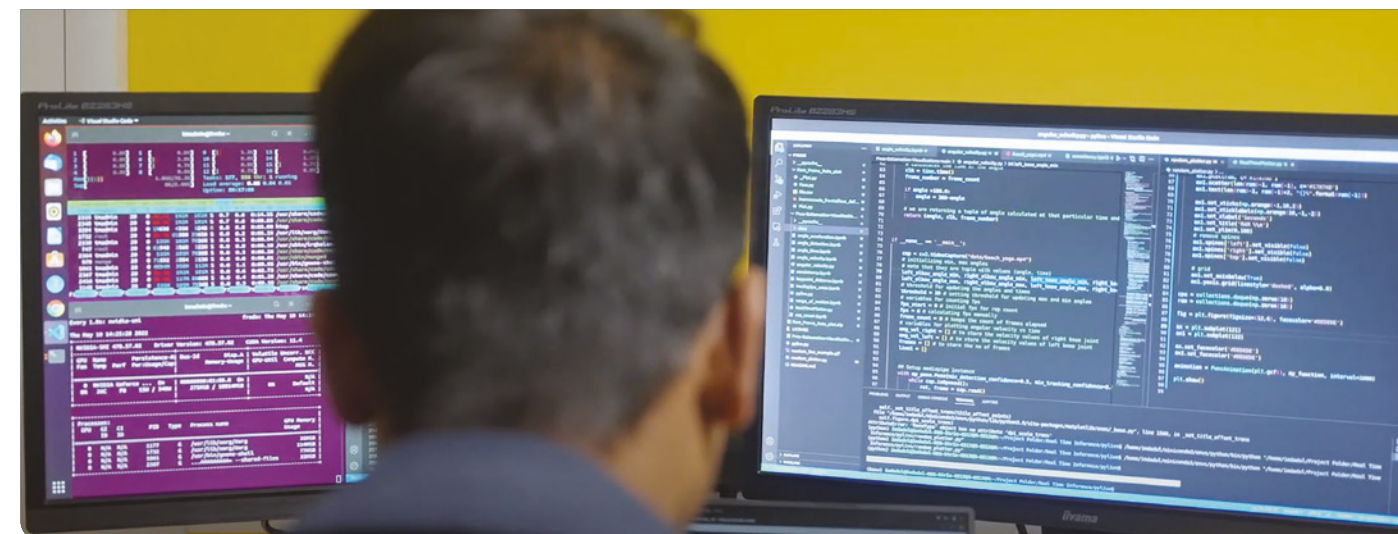


The Company

Established in 2016, Agile Kinetic have a vision in health to make effective, personalised care accessible and sustainable. They achieve this by making it as simple and engaging as possible for their users to share information with multidisciplinary clinical teams, via their MoveLab® MobilityHub© platforms. The company was also a Wales Start UP Award finalist in 2021.

Peter Bishop, Founder and Director commented: -

“The SMART Partnership has been a fundamental part of our development from idea to innovation. The project strengthened our existing relationship with Cardiff School of Technologies at Cardiff Metropolitan University to really feel like a long-term partnership. It would have been very difficult for us to find and secure the required talent in such a technical and emerging field without the link to the university. Equally, it would have been incredibly difficult to manage such a technical role, without the support of our academic lead. The project and relationship with the University provided a talent pipeline as we have since recruited the associate and several other students for long- and short-term roles.”

Imdadul Milon, Associate on the project and who has been recruited by Agile Kinetic as a Machine Learning Researcher said: -

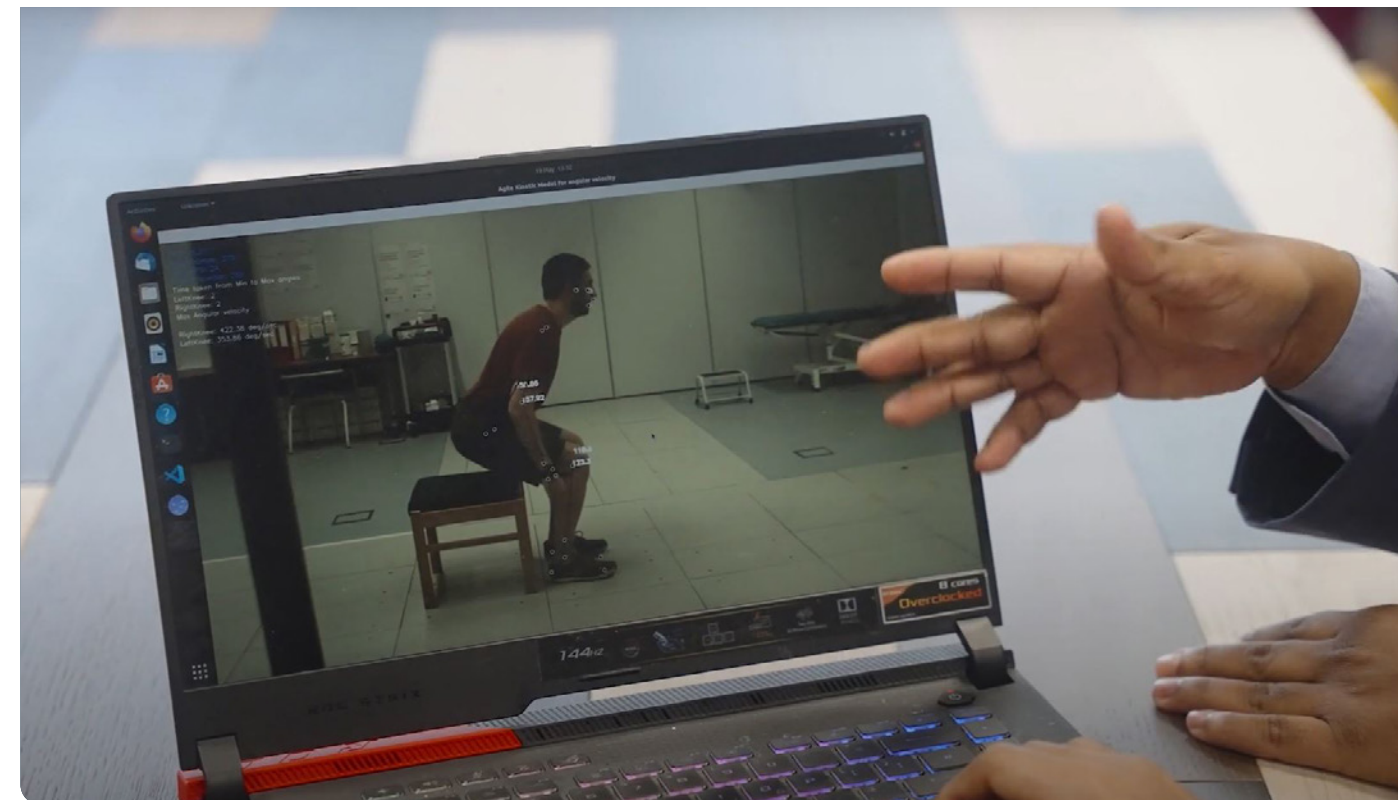

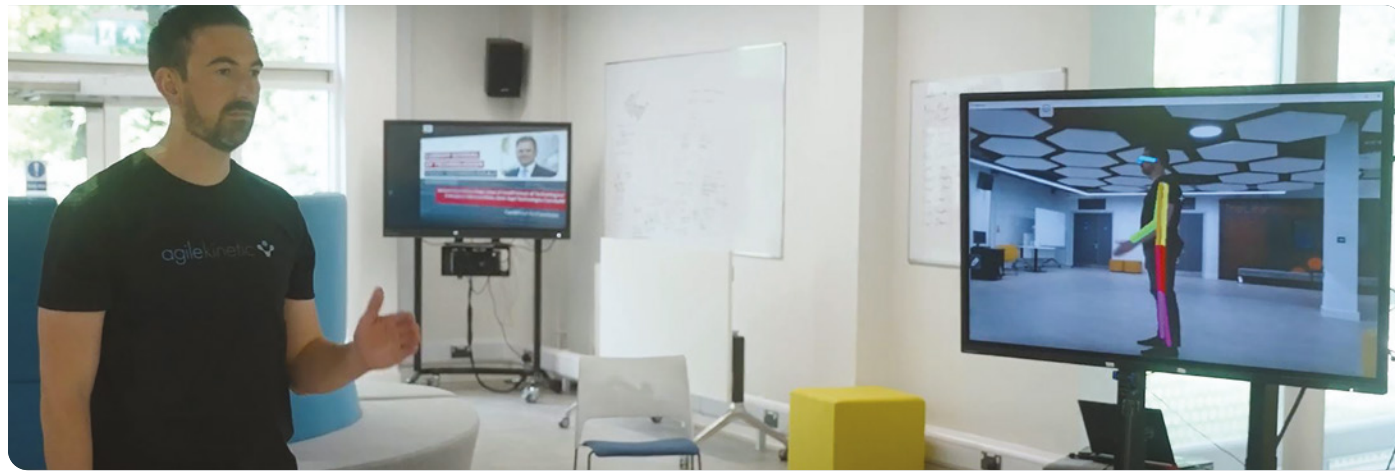


Ynglŷn â phrosiect cydweithio diwydiant-prifysgol Agile Kinetic

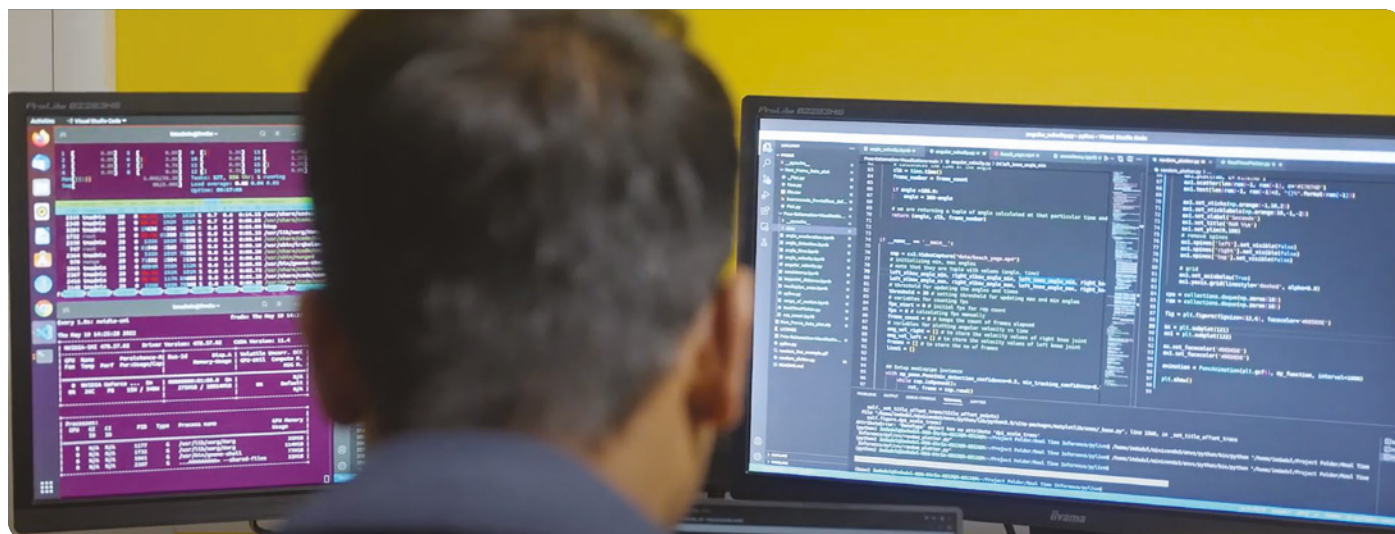
