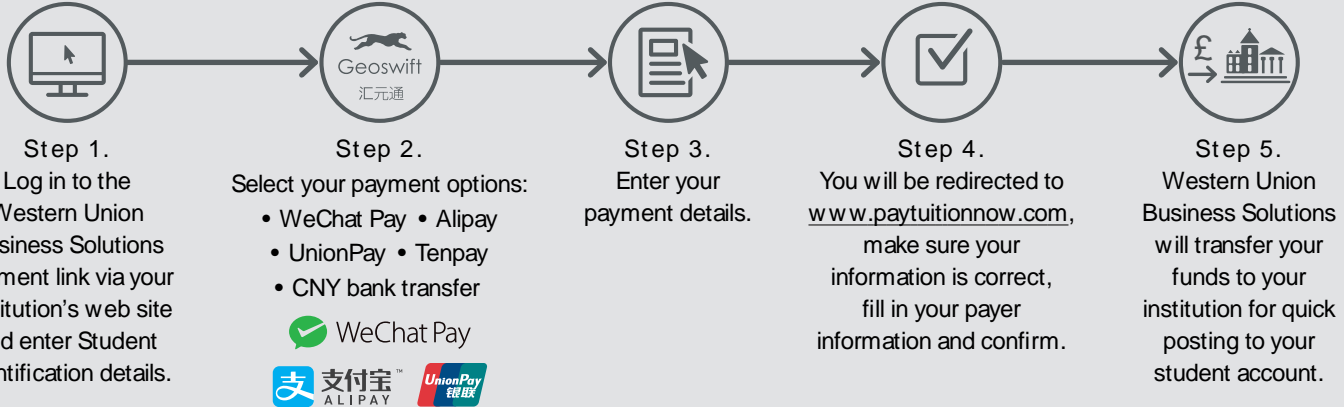
Payment options for students in China
