Bursaries & Scholarships 2024

Carers Bursary

(up to £1000 cash award during the first year of your studies, for Home students)

- Do you care for someone and provide unpaid support to family and/or friends?

You may be eligible for our Carer's Bursary. The Carer's Bursary support package provides you with a dedicated staff mentor to support you and advise on all aspects of university life, as well as a cash award of up to £1,000 during the first year of your course.

Performance and Elite Sports Scholarships (cash award)

A range of scholarship schemes for those that excel in sport (including performance and/or coaching). Eligibility criteria for each scheme varies, to support applications from a range of students.

Sanctuary Award (full tuition-fee remission, and facility award)

For those with an irregular migration status, open to applications from Spring 2024 when full eligibility criteria will be published.

Outside of Cardiff Met, there may be funding options available to you depending on your individual circumstances. We have listed some of the options we have found available on our Bursary and Scholarship webpage.

Undergraduate Specific

Care Leavers and Estranged Student's Bursary (up to £1000 cash per year, for Home students)

- Have you been in care since the age of 14 for at least 13 weeks?
- Are you studying without the support of a family network?

Remember to tick the box on your UCAS form to declare your care experience as you may be eligible for our Care Leavers and Estranged Student's bursary and get in touch with us if you are applying as an estranged student. Care leavers /estranged students are also automatically offered the Study Life bursary (see below).

NHS Support Package (study support, and access to a loaned computer)

A support package for Home students from one of the 10% most deprived areas of Wales entering a full time undergraduate NHS supported undergraduate course. The package includes access to a loaned computer, study skills exercises, tutoring, mentorship, and peer support, among other benefits, to equip you to succeed on your course.

Study Life Award (up to £850 facility award)

This award is centred around a generous catering allowance, and also includes allowances to help with accommodation, print, and travel. Open to Home undergraduate applicants living within designated low participation neighbourhoods with household incomes below £30,000 per year.

Postgraduate Specific

Alumni Discount (up to 20% reduction of tuition fees)

If you are a graduate of the University, or are currently studying at either postgraduate or undergraduate level, you could benefit from the Alumni Discount for your future postgraduate study at CardiffMet.
