## CLEARING BURSARY

### Terms and Conditions 2025/26

#### 1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

You will be automatically assessed and awarded the bursary **if you meet all** the following requirements:

- A. You must be classed as a **Home student** for fee paying purposes.
- B. You must be a **new Cardiff Metropolitan University student with no previous enrolments, applying through UCAS as a Clearing applicant, and entering a full-time undergraduate course at year one, two, three or foundation level starting in 2025. You will need your clearing offer to have been confirmed and be enrolled at Cardiff Met by the 29th September 2025.**
- C. **Your permanent address must be in an area that has low participation rates in Higher Education** . \* You can check your address by using the Cardiff Metropolitan University Criteria Checker which asks you to enter both your age and postcode. The address you have used to register with the Student Loans Company will be used in your eligibility assessment. You must use the same postcode when registering for Student Finance as the postcode you have used to register with UCAS.

#### 2. ALLOCATIONS

- A. **Numbers of awardees are limited and subject to budget availability.** The Bursary will be awarded on a first come first served basis dependant on when your enrolment to Cardiff Met was confirmed. If our allocation runs out we will make this known on the Cardiff Met Website and we will no longer be able to issue further awards.
- B. **Confirmation of award** will be sent to assessed and awarded students during September If you have not received a confirmation email by the 15<sup>th</sup> October 2025 please consider yourself as unsuccessful.
- C. You must be **enrolled** at Cardiff Metropolitan University to be entitled to the bursary:
  - I. If you **withdraw** from your course, all elements of the bursary will cease immediately with no possibility of reinstatement in the future.
- D. Students will be considered for the bursary if making a clearing application as a new student from Foundation year or entering at years one, two or three.

#### 3. AWARDS

The total value of the award is **£200**

Once the bursaries have been allocated and communicated to students (no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> October),

you will be contacted by with the details of your award and will be asked to supply your bank details so that payment can be made to you. Payment and provision of the individual award elements can only be activated once you have successfully enrolled onto your full-time degree course, and once your course has started. Failure to supply bank details when asked may result in the withdrawal of the Bursary.

#### 4. LIMITATIONS

- Once you have enrolled, any bursary correspondence may be sent to your Student or personal Email Address
- **Bursary allowances cannot be carried forward year on year.** This is a one time Bursary award and will not be allocated to you for future academic years.
- Students in receipt of an **NHS bursary are not eligible** for the Clearing Bursary award
- This bursary is **not available if you are studying at franchised college.** Please contact your local college to discuss bursaries and scholarships availability.
- The elements of an associated value of the award are **not transferable.** This is an on campus award package, and periods of time spent off campus, such as for course placements, will not qualify a student to transfer the associated value of an element of the Clearing Bursary award. However, please get in touch with the scholarship team if you are having difficulty in receiving the Bursary.
