Thank you for your application to study Podiatry at Cardiff Metropolitan University.

As part of our application process we invite prospective applicants to attend an interview. There will be two interviewers and the interview will last 15-20 minutes. It will take place online using Microsoft Teams. It is not necessary for you to have this software, though you will need an electronic device with a camera, so that interviewers can see you. The purpose of the interview is to give you the opportunity to demonstrate your understanding of what it means to be a registered Podiatrist and that your own values and behaviours are compatible with NHS employment. We are looking for candidates with an understanding of the role of the modern registered Podiatrist and a genuine interest and commitment to the profession, the public and the NHS.

You can find the date of your interview on your UCAS Hub, and you will also be sent a Microsoft Teams invitation by email several days before the interview is due to take place. The invitation will tell you the time of your interview and who the interviewers are. It will also provide weblinks to a Course Talk and other information about the programme and the university.

It is important that you make yourself available on this day, as we are unable to complete an assessment of your application without the information that we will obtain during the interview. We would be grateful if you could confirm as soon as possible via www.ucas.com/dashboard that you are able to attend the interview on this date.
