Interview Information BSc Social Work

Thank you for your application to study BSc Social Work. As part of our recruitment process, we invite applicants to undertake a written task and to attend an individual interview. Interviews will be conducted via Microsoft Teams, therefore, please ensure that you are familiar with how to use Microsoft Teams prior to your interview. The written task will last for about 30 minutes and the interview for approximately 10-15 minutes. The day will commence with a group talk at 9.30am, which will provide a brief overview of the Social Work programme at Cardiff Met and an opportunity for you to meet some of the social work team. You will commence your written tasks immediately following the group talk.

In preparation for your written task and interview, you should familiarise yourself with the information on the Social Care Wales website relating to the Social Care Wales' Code of Professional Practice for Social Care (2017) (link to document: [untitled \(socialcare.wales\)](#)) and social care legislation in Wales.

Please also ensure you complete the Self-declaration forms and the proof of hours form and return these to the social work team prior to your interview, on socialwork@cardiffmet.ac.uk

Confirmation of your date for interview can be found on the email from Cardiff Met regarding your interview invitation and on your UCAS Hub. **You will also be sent two Microsoft Teams invitations by email several days before the interview is due to take place, one inviting you to the 9.30am talk and the other confirming the time of your individual interview and who the interviewers are.**

During the interview we encourage you to ensure that both your video and your sound remain on at all times as this enables a more engaged environment for both yourself and us as interviewees.
