As Programme Director of the BSc (Hons) Sport Performance Analysis, I would like to welcome you to Cardiff Metropolitan University and the School of Sport and Health Sciences.

Induction Week starts on Monday 28th September. Induction activities will take place predominately online via Microsoft Teams. The Admissions team will send you all the necessary information on how to access Microsoft Teams.

We recommend that you [download the MS Teams app](#) to your laptop and / or phone before Monday 28th September and familiarise yourself with how to use this platform. The [Digital Essentials](#) induction will provide new students with the core digital skills you need to complete your studies, including MS Teams.

Once you've enrolled, visit the [Personal Tutor Portal](#) to find out the name of your personal tutor. You'll be automatically added to the correct Microsoft Team with your personal tutor. Prior to Monday 28th September, your personal tutor will send you an invite to join the programme induction activities via Microsoft Teams.

It is important that you join us during Induction Week, as you will be given important information about studying at Cardiff Metropolitan and your programme. We have put together a series of activities to help you familiarise yourself with the University and services available to support you during your studies, get to know other students on your programme and meet with your Programme Director and Personal Tutor. Your Personal Tutor will support you throughout your Cardiff Metropolitan journey.

Term 1 starts on Monday 5th October. In response to Covid-19, the university has adopted a flexible learning and teaching approach. Your health and wellbeing are central to all our decisions and we will support your academic integration and collaboration through online lectures, on-campus face-to-face teaching in small groups, meetings with your personal tutor, etc. You should have already received information about the modules you'll take in term 1 and an outline timetable. You will receive your personalised timetable during the induction week.
