In Wales, over 2,000 children are excluded from

mainstream education and 311 of them are in Cardiff. These children:

- Have reduced life & work skills, lower self-confidence, and poor mental health and wellbeing
- · Are disengaged with their environment

Through environmental education like workshops and mentoring, we aim to:

- Re-engage children with their learning
- Improve the mood and wellbeing of the children
- Increase the children's self-confidence and life skills
- Increase the children's environmental awareness









What is MetZero?

MetZero, is an Campus based zero waste store offering free minimal waste food packs to vulnerable or low-income families via an eco-delivery service.

Needs Assessment

- 30.8% of Cardiff households are living in poverty
- Nutritional food has become less affordable and accessible to these households
- 50% of plastics we use are not recyclable and the remaining 50% is often not recycled properly

We aim to

To help support the families living in poverty whilst protecting the environment, we aim to:

- Create minimal waste meal packs that will be sold at the MetZero shop
- Work with local farmers to produce affordable meals
- Distribute the meal packs to local food clubs.

Sustainability

The project is financially self-sustaining as It is using the 'buy one, donate one' model.

We have space on both campuses for storage meaning we will not have to pay for external storage or facilities.


Enactus members will help to run the store with volunteering opportunities, running it through the SU guarantees that the project can continue to run irrespective of students graduating and leaving Enactus.
