Cardiff Metropolitan University is following up on its highly successful Tempus project with ten Arab universities titled 'Leadership in Higher Education Management' with another Tempus project 'Building Capacity in University management'. The project involves the UK, Italy, Spain, Greece and the four MENA countries. It is a three year programme where several new training ideas are being implemented.

During the first meeting at La Sapienza University in Rome, it was decided to produce a series of 'short courses'. These courses will consist of a two day face-to face training at which the participants are introduced to best Practice in EU universities. The participants are then given individual tasks, connected with the training, to implement at their own institutions. After two months there will be a further face-to-face meeting where participants will provide feedback and learn from each others' experiences.

Topics chosen are:

- Training for Research Professors
- Quality Assurance
- Internationalisation
- Soft Skills

Four multi-cultural teams have been selected and each are managed by an experienced staff member from La Sapienza which is the largest university in Europe.

The meeting will be followed by a string of sub meetings across the four MENA partner universities to develop the courses and make sure that the project meets its objectives within a designated time frame.
